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

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> DAY 2 Saturday 9/6/25

Naples

Naples is the third largest city in Italy, behind only Rome and Milan in terms of population with nearly 1 million citizens. Known as the birthplace of the modern-day pizza, Naples is one of the most ancient cities in all of Europe, and its entire city center has been designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site because of its vast array of architecure.

Explore Naples

In the morning, join a local Neapolitan guide for a walking tour of downtown Naples and learn about the history of the art and architecture of the city. Along the way, you will visit the San Carlo Theater and the striking Sansevero Chapel, which is home to Cristo Velato, an incredibly beautiful marble statue.

Meet a Local Woman

Meet a local woman entrepreneur in the art of jewelry crafting, belonging to a dynasty of

goldsmith starting from early 1800.

Naples Archaeological Museum

Following lunch as a group, visit Naples Archaeological Museum (MANN), one of the most important museums for the abundance and uniqueness of its heritage and for the contribution it offered the European cultural survey.

Most well known as the site of the catastrophic eruption of Mount Vesuvius, Pompeii offers a unique glimpse into ancient life, as the city was well preserved and frozen in time under the volcanic ash that rained down upon the town in AD 79. The site of numerous excavations. Pompeii is a treasure trove for architectural exploration.

National Park

Hike in Vesuvius Hike the trail to the crater of Vesuvius National Park where you will enjoy the majesty of the volcano as well as the amazing views of the entire Gulf of Naples.

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> DAY 4 Monday 9/8/25

Path of the Gods and Positano

The "Path of the Gods," or "Sentiero degli Dei" in Italian, is a famous hiking trail along the Amalfi Coast in Southern Italy. It offers breathtaking views of the Tyrrhenian Sea, rugged cliffs, and picturesque landscapes. The trail runs from the town of Bomerano (a fraction of Agerola) to Nocelle (a fraction of Positano), allowing hikers to experience the stunning beauty of the Amalfi Coast from a unique perspective.

Path of the Gods

Drive to the Amalfi Coast and Agerola. From Agerola, take the breathtaking "Path of the Gods", a journey back in time to the glories of ancient Greece. The panoramic trail is interrupted by glimpses into the local way of life, passing shepherds huts and ancient stone houses carved into the limestone. Stop for lunch in Nocelle, before descending to colorful Positano.

Explore on Your While in Positano, take some time to leisurely explore the village before returning to Naples.

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> DAY 5 Tuesday 9/9/25

Capri

Located on the south side of the Gulf of Naples, the island of Capri served as a haven for artists and writers alike during the second half of the nineteenth century. This island is also the namesake of the popular capri style of pant that is worn by many around the world today.

Capri Today, you will take a ferry ride to the fabled island

> of Capri. Hike along trails to the largest and most opulent of Tiberius' twelve villas on the island, Villa Lysis. Walk through Mediterranean vegetation, with the scent of oak and myrtle permeating the air while you take in vast views of the mainland and the Faraglioni, three towering rock formations just off

the coast.

Lunch in a Local Enjoy a merenda (small bites in the afternoon) today in a local home before you return to Naples.

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DAY 6 Wednesday 9/10/25

Naples to the Aeolian Archipelago

The Aeolian Archipelago is made up of seven islands off the northern coast of Sicily: Lipari, Vulcano, Salina, Stromboli, Filicudi, Alicudi, and Panarea. These islands were all formed as a result of volcanic activity, and there are still two active volcanoes in the archipelago today. You will have the chance to visit four of the seven islands during your adventure!

Breakfast If you are hungry before making landfall, you can

have breakfast on your own in the ferry cafeteria this morning. Otherwise, you can wait to enjoy a quick group breakfast in a cafe upon arrival to the

island.

Explore Lipari After breakfast, visit the archeological museum

which is tucked inside Lipari Castle on the island's eastern bay between Marina Lunga and Marina Corta. Be sure to take in the Greek acropolis and the

Norman cathedral on the island.

Lunch After a lunch of local fish, you will continue on to

Panarea, the only car-free island of the archipelago.

Check into your hotel before dinner.

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DAY 7 Thursday 9/11/25

Aeolian Archipelago: Vulcano-Panarea

Vulcano is the southernmost island in the Aeolian Archipelago, and is home to an active volcano. According to ancient Roman mythology, the island was borne of the clearning of cinders and ash from the god Vulcan's chimeny, and the island was therefore named in his honor.

Visit Vulcano Take a private boat to Vulcano this morning where

you will disembark and hike to the top of the island. From this vantage point, it is possible to observe numerous volcanic phenomena, including smoke clouds, vapor spouts, and sulphuric mud holes

known for their therapeutic properties.

Light Lunch Enjoy a light lunch at a local cheese farm, to savor

the locally produced goat cheese and the home-

made cannoli!

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DAY 8Friday

Aeolian Archipelago: Panarea-Stromboli

Stromboli is the other active volcano in the Aeolian island chain off the coast of Sicily. Only the top third of this volcano is above sea level, and there are still minor eruptions today.

Day at Leisure in Panarea

Savor a leisurely day in Panarea, with the option to embark on a scenic walk to two captivating beaches. You'll be responsible for your own lunch today.

Private Boat to Stromboli This evening, board a private boat to Stromboli. The most active volcano in Europe, Stromboli has been erupting for at least 2,000 years at intervals of approximately 15 minutes, and the lava flows all the way down to the sea. After dusk, the boat approaches the "Sciara del Fuoco" to admire the natural spectacle of volcanic activity, the characteristic vertical eruptions with impressive explosions of incandescent magma. Enjoy the show while having dinner aboard. Return to Panarea for the night.

DAY 9 Saturday 9/13/25

Aeolian Archipelago to Catania

Located at the foot of Mt. Etna, the city of Catania has been buried by lava seventeen time in its history. There are ancient Greek and Roman ruins buried underneath the layers of ash, many of which have been unearthed during excavation activities. In addition to the ancietn ruins, the center of the city features a wide array of examples of Baroque architecture.

Sail to Milazzo After breakfast today, you will embark a boat bound

for Milazzo, a picturesque Sicilian village.

Visit Catania Upon disembarking, drive to Catania, which is

cradled amidst the splendid greenery of the surroundings while opening out to the sea. Catania is known for its grand piazzas, wide roads, and

architecture made of volcanic rock.

Walking Tour After a lunch on your own in one of the city's many

local restaurants, meet your local guide for a walking tour of the city center. Admire the scenic Piazza Duomo with the famous Fountain of the Elephant, the Cathedral of St. Agatha, the city's patron saint, and Piazza Stesicoro, from which you can admire the striking ruins of the amphitheater.

Mount Etna Natural Park Continue towards the Mount Etna Natural Park. Stop

at a local winery to meet the owner, taste his

fabulous wines.

Check in and Dinner

Head to your accommodation for the next two nights on the slopes of Mt. Etna. Following check-in, enjoy dinner with your group at a winery near Mount

Etna.

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> **DAY 10** Sunday 9/14/25

Catania

Mt. Etna is the largest active volcano in Italy, as it lies right above the African and Eurasian convergent tectonic plates. The most recent eruption was in February of 2021.

Hike on Mt. Etna Today you will visit Europe's largest active volcano, Mt. Etna. This towering mountain dominates the skyline of eastern Sicily. You will start your walk at Rifugia Sapienza, which is at 6,000 feet above sea level. Hike among cinder cones and extinct craters over this desolate expanse of the upper portion of Mt. Etna. A spectacular panoramic view of the coast

awaits you.

Lunch and Afternoon Stop for a picnic lunch before returning to your accommodation. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure at

the hotel.

Spend tonight's festive farewell dinner celebrating

all the incredible sights and amazing
