Dress for the Weather

Temperatures range from 40s - 60s°. It can be warm enough to wear a light shirt, or cold enough to need a fleece. Occasional light rain and drizzle can be common. Light woolens, polypropylene fabrics, and wind- and rain-proof clothing are essential. Dressing in layers works best in the UK's changeable weather. Casual clothes are ideal for all parts of this trip.
