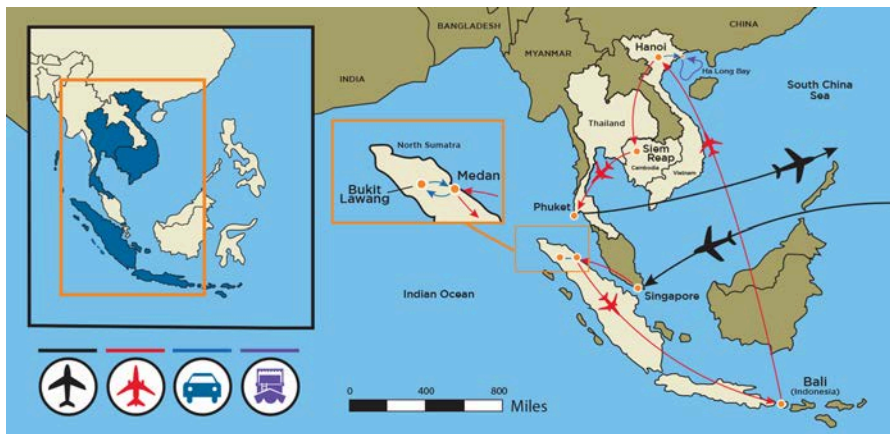
Trip Overview

Day 4

Rainforest Trek & Orangutan Country

Venture deep into Gunung Leuser National Park on a thrilling rainforest trek for roughly 6 hours led by expert rangers. Navigate jungle paths while watching for orangutans, monkeys, gibbons, and vibrant birdlife hidden within the canopy. After the adventure, float back by river tubing along the Bohorok River and enjoy a well-earned lunch. Later, meet educator and changemaker Butet Manurung to hear firsthand about her work with remote Indigenous communities before sharing stories over an intimate evening dinner together.

Day 5

Bat Caves & River Escape

Set out through plantations and countryside trails for an hour toward Bukit Lawang's bat cave, where limestone chambers shelter thousands of bats and swallows. Continue to the calm Landak River for a picnic lunch and time to swim or simply relax in nature. Later, journey (3-4 hour drive) to Medan, watching the landscape shift from jungle to city. Upon arrival, enjoy a brief introduction to North Sumatra's bustling energy before settling in for an evening of comfort and rest.
